Network Time Protocol (NTP) is used to synchronize the computer clock time in a network of computers. NTP used Coordinated Universal Time (UTC) to synchronize computer clock times to a millisecond or less. NTP is one of the oldest Internet protocols in use today, having been in operation since the mid 1980's.

NTP provides synchronization over packet-switched, variable-latency data networks.
