Introduction

This document describes how to download Peach API Security after purchasing directly from Peach Fuzzer's sales team or an authorized reseller. Peach API Security performs security testing of Web Services/APIs. Testing includes OWASP Top-10 and PCI 6.5 security checks as well as fuzz testing. Designed to integrate into modern development models such as Agile and continuous integration (CI) cycles. Integrations with CI systems enable Peach API Security to be run automatically during daily builds. Peach API Security is intended to be integrated into engineering groups with minimal alterations to existing developer workflows.


Peach API Security is distributed as a virtual machine image (OVA) on a per-instance basis. The installation process consists of downloading and installing an OVA and performing some initial configuration steps.

Access the Peach Portal

Peach API Security can be purchased by contacting the Peach Fuzzer sales team sales@peachfuzzer.com or contacting an authorized reseller.

Upon receipt of a signed PO and required end user information, an initial email will be sent by the Peach licensing team containing temporary login instructions. Navigate to your Peach Fuzzer account by following this link: <https://flex1253.flexnetoperations.com/flexnet/operationsportal/logon.do> and change your password.

Next, navigate to the Peach Fuzzer Portal and login with your new credentials: <https://portal.peachfuzzer.com/>
